



JUNE GARDEN REMINDERS

Chores and Maintenance

Prune deciduous and evergreen hedges, spring
flowering trees and shrubs - after blooming
Remove dead, diseased wood from trees and shrubs
Control weeds – pull when soil is damp
Continue to pinch back mums and asters, until July 4th
Stake tall plants
Prune tomato plants
Mulch vegetable garden to control weeds, and water
Water 1” per week
Water lawn a total of 1 – 1-1/2” per week; maintain lawn
height at 2-1/2– 3”

Plant and/or Transplant

Container-grown trees, shrubs, ground covers, annuals
Transplant evergreens and perennials
Start annuals in flats for later summer planting
Transplant warm-season vegetable and herb seedlings to garden
Sow seeds of biennials: sweet william, canterbury bells,
English daisies, foxglove

Fertilize

Roses with organic fertilizer (5-10-5)
Annuals and container plants with water-soluble fertilizer (monthly)
Vegetables with a slow-release fertilizer
